

E-Safety

Pupil E-safety Agreement

For my and other children's online safety in school:

- I will not try to access 'blocked' or inappropriate websites.
- I will only access the internet when I have permission from my teacher.
- I will not share personal or private information online, including my full name, address, school, contact details, photographs, etc.
- I will not communicate with strangers or arrange to meet online contacts in 'real life'.
- I will always be polite and respectful when communicating online.
- I will avoid making unpleasant comments online and will report any cases of cyberbullying against
 myself or others.
- I understand that the school may need to check my online and general computer activity at any time.
- I will tell a trusted adult if I am upset or made to feel uncomfortable by anything online.

To keep the school computer system safe:

- I will use my own login and password, which I will keep safe.
- I will not try to access or alter other people's files and I will not attempt to use somebody else's login or password.
- I will only play online games with a teacher's permission.
- I will not use the school computer system for inappropriate activity, including uploading offensive material, shopping or gaming.
- I will not try to install software without permission from a teacher.
- I will not bring in any food or drink into the computer room.
- I will not deliberately damage any computer equipment.

Personal electronic devices (mobile phones, tablets, etc.):

- I will only bring these to school or use them with permission from a teacher.
- I will follow all of the above rules if I use my own electronic device in school.
- I am responsible for my own devices and their use.
