200 medical conditions can lead to Restricted Growth. A person is short in stature when less than 4'10 inches or 147 cm when fully grown. (Sometimes this can be treated in childhood.) The characteristics of individuals vary greatly.

Short people have no magic powers and just want to be treated like everyone else.

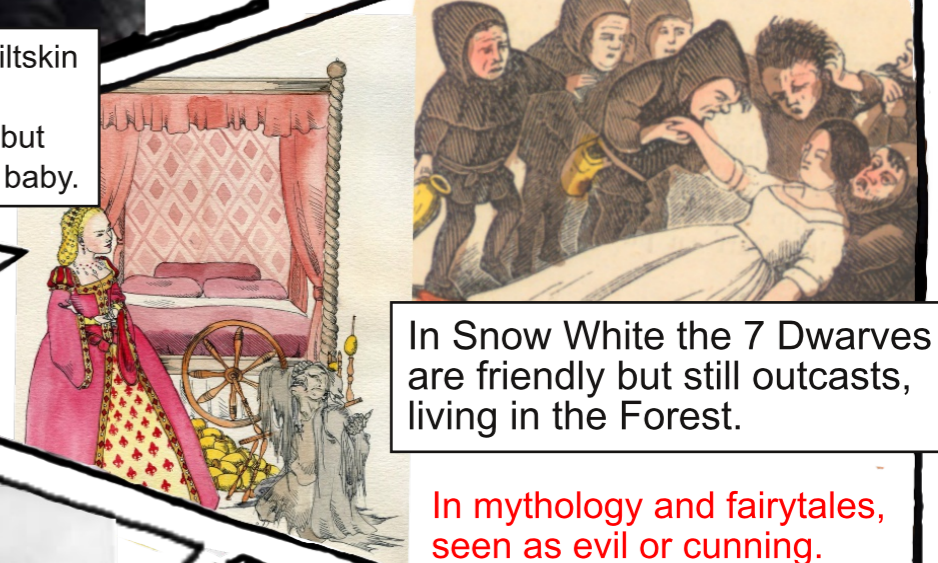
Bullying Harassment
